

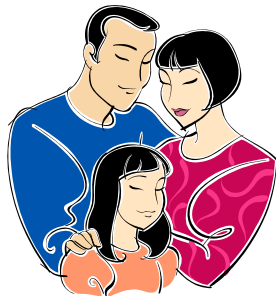
# Enhancing Connections
